Make a [Nolita Shawl](#) (capelet) with 2 skeins of [Cascade Magnum](#) or [Brown Sheep Burly Spun](#).

Make a [Lacy, Chunky Throw](#) in no time with 4 skeins of [Cascade Magnum](#) or [Brown Sheep Burly Spun](#).
